The CPEEP program is funded by California utility ratepayers and administered by Southern California Edison Company through a contract awarded to the Low Income Investment Fund, under the auspices of the California Public Utilities Commission. California customers who choose to participate in this program are not obligated to purchase any additional services offered by the contractor. This program is offered on a first-come first-served basis from 1/1/2010 to 12/31/2012 or until funds are depleted, whichever occurs first. Terms and Conditions apply. WHAT WILL YOU RECEIVE?

Advice on high-efficiency air conditioners, furnace, water heaters, windows, insulation, roofing, and skylights.

ELIGIBILITY

Any licensed child care center operating in the utility service area of Southern California Edison is eligible, regardless of income. Private centers, Head Start, state-contracted preschools and centers located in faith-based organizations, school districts, and other community facilities are eligible.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

1. Eligible facilities receive a free on-site energy assessment.
2. Energy assessment generates a written report with recommendations and expected savings.
3. CPEEP supplies the contractor and pays for labor and materials.
4. Facilities benefit from lower energy usage and lower utility bills.
